

The Deutscher Kreuzer-Yacht-Verband (German Cruiser Yacht Association) was founded in 1911 and became the cruiser section of the Deutscher Segler-Verband (DSV) the German Sailing Federation in 1917.





And Now

Today the Kreuzer-Abteilung des DSV is the largest association of yachtsmen and motorboat owners and enthusiasts in Germany.

We have circa 18,000 members – yachtsmen and women and motorboat owners - and together we represent the interests of water sports enthusiasts on the sea, at the coast and on inland waters.

The DSV (German Sailing Federation) is the national authority for about 1.300 clubs with 180.000 members.








Mission


